[Thebes: Cadmus, Harmonia; Ino; Autonoe - Actaion; Agave - Pentheus;
Semele - Dionysus.]

Pyanepsion ('October' - sowing):

'Proerosia' - Demeter, crops, 'first-fruits'
7th: 'Pyanepsia' - Apollo, branches, fertility (Theseus) **S** 136-7
'Oschophoria' - Dionysus, branches, grapes (Theseus)
8th: 'Theseia' - Poseidon, Theseus
11th - 13th: 'Thesmophoria' - Demeter
